

Data Protection Policy Statement

Without Worry Canine Education needs to keep certain information about its tutors, associates and learners and other users to monitor performance and achievements. To comply with the law, information must be collected and used fairly, stored safely and not disclosed to any other person unlawfully.

To achieve this, Without Worry Canine Education must comply with the Data Protection Principles which are set out in the Data Protection Act 1998 (the 1998 Act).

In summary, the Data Protection Principles state that personal data shall

- Be obtained and processed fairly and lawfully and shall not be processed unless certain conditions are met.
- Be obtained for a specified and lawful purpose and shall not be processed in any manner incompatible with that purpose.
- Be adequate, relevant, and not excessive.
- Be accurate and kept up to date.
- Not be kept for longer than is necessary.
- Be processed in accordance with the data subject's rights.
- Be kept safe from unauthorised access, accidental loss, or destruction.
- Not be transferred to a country outside the European Economic Area, unless that country has equivalent levels of protection for personal data.

Refund and transfer policy for online courses
